



**PRIMETIME HEALTH PLAN**  
**Monthly Plan Premium for People who get Extra Help from Medicare**  
**to Help Pay for their Prescription Drug Costs**

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be lower than what it would be if you did not get extra help from Medicare.

If you get extra help, your monthly plan premium will be lower for any of the plans below. (This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.) The table below shows you what your monthly plan premium will be if you get extra help.

If you get extra help from Medicare to help pay for your Medicare prescription drug plan costs, your monthly plan premium will be \$0 for the plan below. (This does not include any Medicare Part B premium you may have to pay.)
