

Potassium Chloride – Glenmark

On June 24, 2024, Glenmark announced a recall of several lots of potassium chloride extended-release capsules because the capsules may not work as intended and cause the amount of potassium in your blood to be higher than normal.

Per Glenmark, using the recalled potassium chloride capsules may cause the amount of potassium in your blood to be higher than normal and lead to serious health effects such as irregular heartbeat and muscle weakness. Seek immediate medical care if you experience any issues that might be related to using the recalled product.

Use the table below to check the NDC number on your prescription. Call your pharmacist if you need help.

Contact your pharmacy and ask if you can get a replacement. You may not need a new prescription. Do not stop taking your potassium chloride capsules without first talking to your doctor.
